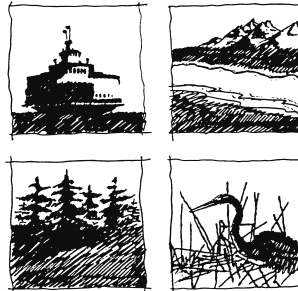


# BAINBRIDGE ISLAND LAND TRUST
