1. Species Name: Beaked Hazelnut (Corylus cornuta)

1 gallon - \$10


Sun/Shade Tolerance: Prefers shade

Soil Requirements: Prefers well-drained sites

Height: 3 feet – 13 feet Growth Form: Shrub

At a glance: Monoecious shrub, male catkins emerge before leaves in the spring, female catkins are much smaller with protruding red stigmas. Flowers in February

and March.

Soil Requirements: Moist Height: Up to 1.5 feet Growth Form: Herb

At a glance: Pink to purplish heart-shaped flower with 4 petals; 5-15 in drooping clusters atop stem; flowers in

March, April, May, and June.





3. Species Name: Cascade Oregon grape (Mahonia nervosa)

Sun/Shade Tolerance: Prefers shady areas (cloudy

Soil Requirements: Can tolerate both moist and

dry soils.

Height: Up to 2 feet Growth Form: Shrub

At a glance: Glossy, holly-like leaves; small bright

yellow flowers in elongated clusters; flowers in April and May.



4. Species Name: Cascara (Rhamnus purshiana)

Sun/Shade Tolerance: Mostly sunny/partial


shade (partly cloudy icon)

Soil Requirements: Wet/Moist/Dry

Height: Up to 33 feet Growth Form: Tree

At a glance: Alternate egg-shaped to oblong

dark glossy green leaves; small flowers with 5 petals; flowers in April and May.

shady (cloudy icon) Soil Requirements: Moist Height: Up to 10 inches Growth Form: Herb

At a glance: 4-7 leaves in a single terminal; small cluster of greenish-white flowers in the center; may bloom twice; flowers in May and June.





6. Species Name: Deer Fern (*Blechnum spicant*)

Sun/Shade Tolerance: Prefers shade (cloudy icon)

Soil Requirements: Moist Height: Up to 40 inches Growth Form: Fern

At a glance: dark green leaves; produces spores on special modified leaves held upright above the

vegetative leaves; no flowers.



7. Species Name: Douglas Fir (*Pseudotsuga menziesii*)

Sun/Shade Tolerance: Full sun/mostly sunny (sunny icon)

Soil Requirements: Moist/Dry

Height: Up to 300 feet Growth Form: Tree

At a glance: Needles 2-3 cm long with pointed tips; produces

reddish-brown pollen cones.

8. Species Name: Douglas Iris (Iris douglasiana)

Sun/Shade Requirements: Sunny/partial sun (sunny icon)

Soil Requirements: Well-drained

Height: 1-2 feet Growth Form: Herb

At a glance: Sword-shaped dark green leaves; usually blue

flowers; enjoys meadow settings.





9. Species Name: Douglas Spiraea

Sun/Shade Requirements: Full sun/mostly sunny (sunny icon)

Soil Requirements: Wet/moist

Height: 2-8 feet Growth Form: Shrub

At a glance: Pink flowers that bloom in May, June, and July



10. Species Name: Evergreen Huckleberry (Vaccinium ovatum)

Sun/Shade Requirements: Mostly sunny/ partial sun and

shade (partly sunny icon) Soil Requirements: Moist/dry

Height: Up to 4 meters Growth Form: Shrub

At a glance: Small evergreen, dark glossy green leaves; flowers are bell-shaped and pink; flowers in April, May, June, and July; produces dark purplish-black berries.



11. Species Name: False Lily-of-the-Valley (Maianthemum dilatatum)

Sun/Shade Requirements: Mostly shady/full shade

(cloudy icon)

Soil Requirements: Moist Height: Up to 12 inches Growth Form: Herb

At a glance: Large heart-shaped leaves; leaf surfaces are glossy green; small delicate white flowers; flowers in

April, May, and June.



12. Species Name: Fringecup (Tellima grandiflora)



Soil Requirements: Moist Height: Up to 1 foot Growth Form: Herb

At a glance: Clump-forming perennial; dark green leaves; pink flowers that bloom in April, May, June, and July.

Height: Up to 28 inches Growth Form: Herb

At a glance: Numerous basal, grass-like leaves; 5 or more deep blue flowers in a long terminal spike; flowers in

April and May.





14. Species Name: Hairy Honeysuckle (*Lonicera hispidula*)

Sun/Shade Requirements: Full sun/mostly sunny (sunny

icon)

Soil Requirements: Dry Height: Up to 33 feet Growth Form: Vine

At a glance: Oval-shaped leaves; dark green leaves; tubular flowers 1-2 cm long; pinkish-purple flowers; flowers in

May, June, and July.



15. Species Name: High Bush Cranberry (Viburnum edule)

Sun/Shade Requirements: Full sun/mostly sunny (sunny icon)

Soil Requirements: Moist

Height: 3-9 feet Growth Form: Shrub

At a glance: Maple-shaped leaves with 3 lobes; leaves turn bright red in fall; clusters of small white flowers;

flowers in May, June, and July.



16. Species Name: Idaho Blue Eyed Grass (Sisyrinchium idahoense)

Sun/Shade Requirements: Full sun/mostly sunny

(sunny icon)

Soil Requirements: Wet/Moist

Height: 28 inches Growth Form: Herb

At a glance: Mostly basal leaves; long and

narrow; blue to bluish-purple flower; flowers in March, April, May, and June



17. Species Name: Kinnikinnick (Arctostaphylos unva-ursi)

Sun/Shade Requirements: Full sun/mostly

sunny (sunny icon)

Soil Requirements: Dry/well-drained

Height: 6-12 inches Growth Form: Shrub

At a glance: Mat-forming evergreen shrub;

produces pink flowers that turn into red berries; velvety red-brownish branches;

flowers in March and April.



18. Species Name: Maidenhair Fern (Adiantum aleuticum)

Sun/Shade Requirements: Partial sun/mostly

shady (cloudy icon)

Soil Requirements: Moist

Height: 6-43 inches

Growth Form: Herb or fern

At a glance: Stems are shiny and wirey; ranging

in color from dark brown to purplish.



19. Species Name: Mock Orange (*Philadelphus lewisii*)



Height: Up to 10 feet Growth Form: Shrub

At a glance: Oval to egg-shaped green leaves; flowers with 4 petals; flowers in

May, June, and July.

Height: Up to 13 feet Growth Form: Shrub

At a glance: Deeply veined shiny dark green leaves; white, small flowers with 5

petals; flowers in May and June.

21. Species Name: Nootka Rose (Rosa nutkana)

Sun/Shade Requirements: Mostly sunny (sunny

icon)

Soil Requirements: Moist/Dry

Height: Up to 10 feet Growth Form: Shrub







At a glance: Alternate compounded leaves with rounded tips; large flower of pink color; saucer-shaped; flowers in May and June.

22. Species Name: Oregon Iris (Iris tenax)

Sun/Shade Requirements: Mostly sunny/partial sun

(sunny icon)

Soil Requirements: Wet/Moist/Dry

Height: Up to 16 inches Growth Form: Herb

At a glance: Mainly basal, long and narrow leaves;

blue to purple flowers with yellow/white highlights; flowers in May and June



23. Species Name: Pacific Madrone (Arbutus menziesii)

1 gallon - \$10

Sun/Shade Requirements: Partial shade

(partly cloudy icon)
Soil Requirements: Dry
Height: Up to 100 feet
Growth Form: Tree

At a glance: Supports multiple moth and

butterfly species; alternate, evergreen leaves are dark shiny green; small pinkish-

white, bell-shaped flowers; flowers in April.



24. Species Name: Pacific Rhododendron (Rhododendron macrophyllum)

Sun/Shade Requirements: Full sun/mostly sunny (sunny icon)

Soil Requirements: Moist/Dry

Height: Up to 26 feet

At a glance: Alternate, evergreen leaves; pink to rose-purple, bell-shaped flowers; flowers in May,

June, and July.



25. Species Name: Red Elderberry (Sambucus racemosa)

Sun/Shade Requirements: Full sun/mostly sunny (sunny

icon)

Soil Requirements: Moist



Height: 20 feet

Growth Form: Tree or shrub

At a glance: Pointed, sharply-toothed leaves, somewhat hairy; clusters of small creamy-white flowers; small bright red berry-like drupes; flowers in May, June,

and July.

26. Species Name: Red Flowering Currant (Ribes sanguineum)

Sun/Shade Requirements: Full sun/mostly sunny

(sunny icon)

Soil Requirements: Dry

Height: 3-10 Feet Growth Form: Shrub

At a glance: 3-5-lobed green leaves; pale pink to deep red flower clusters; produces blue-black berries; flowers in February, March, and April.



27. Species Name: Red Huckleberry (Vaccinium parvifolium)

Sun/Shade Requirements: Mostly sunny

(sunny icon)

Soil Requirements: Moist

Height: 4-10 feet Growth Form: Shrub

At a glance: Small, oval-shaped leaves with smooth margins; bell-shaped greenish pink flowers; produces bright red smooth round huckleberries; flowers in March, April, and May.



28. Species Name: Red Twig Dogwood (Cornus sericea)

Sun/Shade Requirements: Full sun (sunny icon)

Soil Requirements: Moist

Height: 6-9 feet

Growth Form: Shrub

At a glance: Ovate, medium to dark green leaves that acquire shades of red to

orange.



29. Species Name: Redwood Sorrel (Oxalis oregana)

4" pot - \$4

Sun/Shade Requirements: Mostly shady (cloudy

icon)

Soil Requirements: Moist/dry

Height: 6-12 inches Growth Form: Herb

At a glance: Delicate, evergreen herb with clover-like leaves; white to pink flowers;

flowers from April - September.

30. Species Name: Salal (Gaultheria shallon)

Sun/Shade Requirements: Full sun/shade (partly cloudy

icon)

Soil Requirements: Moist/Dry

Height: 3-7 feet

Growth Form: Shrub

At a glance: Evergreen, leathery, shiny dark green leaves; 5-15 white-to-pinkish

urn-shaped flowers; flowers in May and June.

31. Species Name: Serviceberry (Amelanchier alnifolia)

1 gallon - \$10

Sun/Shade Requirements: Full sun/mostly

sunny (sunny icon)

Soil Requirements: Moist/Dry

Height: Up to 15 feet Growth Form: Shrub

At a glance: Leaves are round to oval

shape and green; clusters of large white flowers with 5 petals; flowers in April and

May; produces berry-like fruits that are called pomes.







32. Species Name: Shore Pine (*Pinus contorta*)

1 gallon - \$10

Sun/Shade: Full sun/mostly sun

(sunny icon)

Soil Requirement: Moist/Dry

Height: Up to 100 feet Growth Form: Tree

At a glance: Needles in pairs, often curved and deep green; produces pinecone 3-5 cm long, egg-shaped,

usually slightly curved, scales stiff and brown.



33. Species Name: Sword Fern (*Polystichum munitum*)

Sun/Shade: Mostly to full shade

(cloudy icon)

Soil Requirements: Moist/Dry

Height: 3-5 feet Growth Form: Fern

At a glance: Large attractive fern with erect evergreen fronds forming

a circular crown.



34. Species Name: Tall Oregon Grape (Mahonia aquifolium)

Sun/Shade: Partial/full sun (partly cloudy

icon)

Soil Requirements: Moist/dry

Height: Up to 8 feet Growth Form: Shrub

At a glance: Evergreen shrub with 5-9 leaflets; grows by spreading from

underground roots; bright yellow clustered flowers; flowers bloom in spring.



35. Species Name: Trumpet Honeysuckle (Lonicera ciliosa)

Sun/Shade Requirements: Full

sun/mostly sunny

Soil Requirements: Moist Height: Up to 20 feet Growth Form: Vine

At a glance: End-pair leaves on each twig join to form a disk; stems leaves are oval; narrowly trumpet-shaped orange flower; flowers in May and June.



36. Species Name: Vine Maple (Acer circinatum)

Sun/Shade Requirements: Partly sunny/mostly

shady (partly sunny icon) Soil Requirements: Wet/Moist

Height: 13-26 feet Growth Form: Shrub

At a glance: Tall, erect, multi-trunked shrub or small tree with sprawling branches.

37. Species Name: Western Azalea (Rhododendron occidentale)

Sun/Shade Requirements: Partial shade (partly

cloudy icon)

Soil Requirements: Moist

Height: 6-15 feet Growth Form: Shrub

At a glance: Glossy, bright-green leaves; large

floral trusses; sparkling white flowers.





38. Species Name: Western Red Cedar (Thuja plicata)

1 gallon - \$10

Sun/Shade Requirements: Mostly

shade (cloudy icon)

Soil Requirements: Moist/Wet Soil

Height: 100-230 feet Growth Form: Tree

At a glance: Large conifer branches that droop and then back up broad

crowns.



39. Species Name: Western Trillium (Trillium ovatum)

1 gallon - \$10

Sun/Shade Requirements: Partial sun and shade (partly

cloudy icon)

Soil Requirements: Wet/Moist

Height: 12-18 inches Growth Form: Herb

At a glance: Leaves are in whorls of three; leaves are unstalked; solitary flower with three white petals;

flowers in March, April, and May.



40. Species Name: White Inside-Out Flower (Vancouveria hexandra)

1 gallon - \$10

Sun/Shade Requirements: Partial sun/mostly shady

(cloudy icon) Height: 16 inches Growth Form: Herb

At a glance: Leaves are twice divided into 3's;

leaflets are sparsely hair; flowers have 6 petals; flowers in May, June, and July.

Sun/Shade Requirements: Mostly shady/full

shade (cloudy icon) Height: Up to 8 inches Growth Form: Herb

At a glance: Leaves emerge in pairs along the rhizome on hairy leaf stalks; solitary purplishbrown to greenish-yellow flowers; flowers in

April, May, and June.
